Ken Tyrell was the pre-eminent mentor of Formula 1 car drivers during the late 1960s and 1970s. He gave such outstanding talents such as Jackie Stewart, Jody Scheckter, Francois Cevert, Patrick Depailler, and Jean Alesi their first opportunity in the big leagues. Ken, sadly no longer with us, was born on this date.

Format: The school for the first time will feature two levels- beginning and intermediate.

- Schedule: Thursday, May 1, 6pm: Intermediate Ground School Friday, May 2, 6pm: Novice Ground School Saturday, May 3: Registration opens 7:30 am, closes 8 am. First on course exercise at 9.
- Locations: Ground School will be at C2 Motorsports, 8380 Vickers Street, Suite D, San Diego, 92111. Driving exercises will be held on the West Lot of Qualcomm Stadium.
- Costs: \$65, including lunch and weekend membership in the SCCA (if needed)

Maximum Entries: 60

Requirements: Snell M95 or SA95 (or later) certified helmet. A limited number of loaner helmets will be available. Close toed shoes. A car which can pass a safety inspection. Two drivers may share one car, provided they are in the same level. A good attitude and a gratuity for your instructor (kidding! About the gratuity part, anyway). Intermediate students should have attended a prior school or have 20 autocrosses (or equivalent track experience) under their belts.
