Event pre-registration will be available online at <http://msreg.com/dccsdpractice>. Online registration will close on Oct. 17 at 12 Midnight. Registering online will let you see which groups are available in real-time and will ensure you get into the desired run group.

Registration check-in cutoff for Group A & B is 8:40 A.M. and for Group C & D is 11:30 A.M. After that we will allow wait list drivers to fill in any opening.

Practice Format: limited to 100 entries; four run groups of 25 each; 90 min. per group

Jr. Karts will run in the end of Group B. Each kart will make 8 back-to-back runs. Second driver sharing a kart will run in beginning of Group C.

All drivers MUST be members of the SCCA. Weekend SCCA membership is available at event (\$15). All drivers MUST have a San Diego Region Solo Card. Weekend Region Solo Pass is available at event (\$5).

ENTRY FEE: Primary Driver \$45 (any driver entering a car in a run group)
All Secondary Drivers \$15 (a secondary driver is any non-primary driver. e.g. a second driver sharing an entry in a run group, driving instructors, etc.)

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS: Vehicle must pass safety inspection, helmet (Snell 2000 or newer)

NOISE RESTRICTIONS: A Maximum noise level of 93.0 dBA @ 50 ft. for all participants will be enforced

ONLINE REGISTRATION

HOW DOES ONLINE REGISTRATION WORK?

On a trial basis, we are offering online registration at MotorsportReg.com. This website is not just used by the SCCA national office for registering entrants for national events, but also by many SCCA regions for their autocross programs. MotorsportReg.com is also used widely by the BMW Car Club of American (BMWCCA) and the Porsche Club of America (PCA).

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

Here are the steps involved if you do not have an account.

1. Go to www.sdr-solo.motorsportreg.com
2. On the right side, near the top of the page, you'll see a box labeled "Create Account". Click on the link. You'll be taken through a series of pages to register as a user.
3. Once you have created an account, you'll be ready to register for the event.
4. Go back to the "HOME" page of www.sdr-solo.motorsportreg.com.
5. Click on "SDR-SCCA DCCSD PRACTICE". Since you have already registered for the website, most of the information on the event page should populate itself. Select the event specific options, proceed to payment, and afterwards, you'll be registered.
6. You'll receive an acknowledgement email right away confirming the details. Should you need to make changes, simply log into your account and make the run group changes provided they are open.

HOW DOES ONLINE PAYMENT WORK?

You enter a valid credit card number/e-check at the time of registration in order for MotorsportReg.com to authorize the payment. The payment will actually not be processed until the business day following the event. We realize plans change and as such we have included our cancellation policy below.

WHAT IS THE CANCELLATION POLICY?

Cancellations received by Thursday, October 17, 2013 are refundable. Cancellations received after Thursday, October 17, 2013 are non-refundable.
