## From Todd:

Here's my report for the Course Committee:

- Lake Elsinore set-up will be on Friday morning.
- Region event course was done by Bry Morris and a handful of CAM drivers. It was Bry's first time designing or setting up courses, and most of the guys had never been involved either. I thought they did a fantastic job. Both days' courses flowed well, were safe, fun and easy to read. To my knowledge, we had no DNF's either day that were the result of drivers getting lost. That success should be a model for every SDR event.

Club course designers, PLEASE take a note of that fact. I'd like to see all courses lined, and particular attention paid to making the marking easy to read for everyone- not just those of us who are experienced.

One particular detail I'd like to note is the use of the laydown cones by Bry and his team. During set-up, several of the less-experienced drivers were placing them, and I thought many were unnecessary. Since this was as much a learning opportunity as a set-up day, I figured we'd walk in the morning as a group, and I'd show them that those were not really needed, once the course was lined. As it turned out, I was absolutely wrong.

After giving it some thought, I realized that a group of less-experienced drivers put them there because they needed the visual aid. BIG lesson for me, to remember to think outside of my own box, and not be afraid to add visual aids that might seem too obvious. Those laydown cones remained, and I believe they were a key to the successful ease of reading these courses.

Course designers, please give this some thought, and don't be afraid to make your course marking very obvious. If a course's challenge is figuring out where the course is supposed to be going, instead of figuring out the fast line through it, we have failed as course designers.

We have a lot of talented course designers in this region, and we should never have courses that are difficult to read. Kudos to Bry and the group for showing us how it's done!
